





Choreographers, Emmanuelle LêPhan and Elon Höglund combine elements of contemporary dance, street dance and martial arts in a physical score that echoes the subtle pulse of respiration - inhalations and exhalations sculpt the group's gestures and movements.



Created within the lands of the Six Nations of the Grand River, Canada and Piha, Aotearoa (NZ), the performance affirms First Nation womxn's kinship relationship to all living entities. Weaving performance, video and music, Blood, Water, Earth channels the ancestral, elemental and dream world. Embodied storyteller/Director Santee Smith performs a physical incantation, traversing the sacred alignment from cosmos to womb to earth, a symbolic ritual renewal, and a conscious stripping away of colonial impacts.

Bygones celebrates how we are shaped by what we overcome and how something challenging can lead to something beautiful. It explores a past that clings to the present, a connection that runs through space, people, objects and time.

Dancers are in flux. The movement is rigorous, hyper detailed and virtuosic. Ghostly architecture, puppeteering and illusions create a world of phony things and supernatural selves. A physical lawlessness teases a sense of reality, overthrowing logic and starting afresh.

The work explores the link between creation and destruction, form and formlessness. Change is the problem and the solution, earning transformation and the ability to reconnect.

Choreographer, singer and author Dorothée Munyaneza has created a dance and vocal performance for six female African or of African descent artists. Each of their voices and bodies tells a unique story of journey, commitment and strength. The artists on stage boldly and freely manifest an

intimate and collective memory. Munyaneza weaves these stories together and creates a symphony of voices. In collaboration with artist and designer Stéphanie Coudert, costume and fabric provide a common thread on stage and interrogate femininity and freedom of the body.
